### Learn to draw

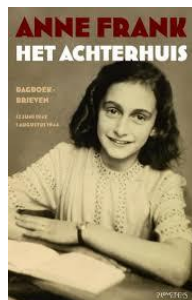

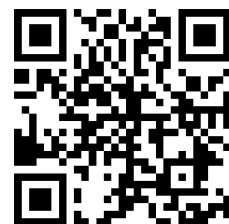
### Museum at home
